From September 2015 to August 2019 we met as a portable church in the Bonita Springs Middle School. In August 2019, we moved as a portable church to Bonita Springs High School in hopes of growth in a larger facility. When the COVID changes started in March 2020, we were forced to go online only. We were strictly an online church for the remainder of 2020. In January 2021, we were able to rent a building of our own, and we are still there. Today, Turning Point Church is a family-friendly church that reaches multiple generations both in-person and online. We have a strong passion for outreach locally and globally and a reputation in our community that embraces that.

Overview of Weekly Worship Gathering

We have a single service on Sunday morning at 10:00 AM. It has contemporary music and Scripture-based messages. People like the messages, informal setting, passionate preaching, and Kid's ministry.

Worship Style of Your Church

Turning Point's worship style is best described as contemporary worship. We use music from churches/artists such as Bethel, Hillsong, Elevation, Red Rocks Worship, Phil Wickham and UpperRoom. Most of the music is current or released within the last couple of years, however sometimes we will arrange hymns into the contemporary worship if appropriate.. In preparing for the week's worship, the focus is to facilitate a meaningful experience through authentic worship. Songs are chosen with focus on praise for what God has done and continues to do, recognition that we are broken and have fallen short and are in need of a Savior, praise and thanksgiving for Jesus' love, sacrifice honoring the risen King.

Tell Us About Your Facility

We lease a 7,000 sq ft building that was built in 1998. It used to host three separate companies, so it is a great setup for the kid's ministry and a separate area for the auditorium. The auditorium can seat up to 125 with current seating. The auditorium has a main floor for the stage, seating, and tech booth with an upstairs loft. The loft area has three TV's to make viewing easy from the back side of the loft.

Overall Budget (this fiscal year)

Using a conservative approach, for 2023 we are currently using a basic fixed cost budget to be reviewed as the year progresses and we understand better what our revenue looks like in this transition. Our budget for 2023 amount is around \$400K. This will be reviewed mid-year and adjusted based on the current revenue/expense picture.



Overall Long-Term Debt of the Church

We have a small loan from Landmark association taken at time of planting. The church was encouraged to take the loan at startup to front load the available funds so we could purchase what was necessary and do ministry well from day one.

- Children's Ministry We have three different age groups. Nursery (newborn 2.5 years), preschool (2.5 years CPK), elementary (K-5).
- Youth Group 6th 12th
- The Gathering Throughout the year, we meet for six-week timeframes. Various topics are discussed, as well as a meal and community building. This is a staff led gathering.

Outreach Programs Overview

.TPC has a heart for outreach in Southwest Florida. There are three corporations that we partner with.

New Horizons: The purpose of their business is to provide after-school care, tutoring, and devotionals for low-income families. Monday through Thursday each week during the school year, volunteers from TPC go to New Horizons to provide tutoring for up to 65 kids. On a monthly basis, we distribute a mobile pantry to a low-income area of the Bonita Springs community providing food and prayer with each family. The food is the connection to get into the community, the prayer and a relationship is the ultimate goal. 99% of the families provide prayer requests and are willing to pray with us on a monthly basis.



- Pregnancy Resource Center of Naples is a partner of Turning Point Church. PRC is a Christian based organization providing Intervention, Intercession, Education and Integration..
- Better Together of Naples: The goal of Better Together is to keep families together and children out of foster care. In addition to financial support, members of the congregation are trained to host small children while mothers are coached to support themselves. Other congregants are trained to be mentors to mothers of small children. Since 2015, Better Together served more than 3,000 children and 34,000 job seekers through two highly successful programs: Better Families and Better Jobs. By empowering people who truly want to help themselves, Better Together is poised to prevent child abuse and neglect before it happens and match employers to employees who simply need a hand up or second chance.

- About the Bible | We believe the Bible is inspired by God and that His Spirit directed men to write His words; therefore, we believe that it contains no errors. (See 2 Timothy 3:15-17; 1 Thessalonians 2:13; 2 Peter 1:21)
- About God | We believe that there is only one God who exists in three distinct persons: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. (See Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 43:10-11; Matthew 28:19; Luke 3:22)
- About Jesus | We believe that Jesus was born of the Virgin Mary, that he is both God and man, that he never sinned, and that he performed miracles. Jesus died, was buried and rose from the dead so that sins can be forgiven. Jesus is now with the Father in heaven but will someday return to earth in power and glory. We are filled by the Holy Spirit when we yield to God';s authority in our life and ask Him to fill us. - About Mankind | We believe that all people are created in the image of God to have fellowship with Him but became alienated in that relationship through sin, rebelling against God's will. Therefore, a person is incapable of regaining a right relationship with God through his or her own effort alone. (See Genesis 1:27; Romans 3:23; Galatians 3:22; Ephesians 2:8-9)
- About Salvation | We believe that the blood of Jesus Christ provides the sole basis for the forgiveness of sin. Therefore, only those who place their faith in Jesus' sacrifice on the cross will be saved. When a person believes in Jesus, God--the Holy Spirit gives that person a brand new life--he or she is born anew. (See Luke 24:47; John 3:3; Romans 10:13-15; Ephesians 2:8; Galatians 4:6)

- Leading those who have a deeper interest in the church through the next steps of church partnership.
- Provide counsel to those who are seeking wisdom or guidance in their lives. When necessary, recommend someone to a local counselor for longer-term Christ-centered care.

It is helpful for the pastor to be comfortable with turning on equipment (directions are documented) and having some baseline knowledge in Pro Presenter as this is our Sunday morning presentation software.
