### **Community Overview**

Greenville, in eastern North Carolina, is a vibrant college town, home of East Carolina University, Vidant Medical Center, and Pitt Community College. Greenville is a necessary and attractive destination for towns and small cities throughout eastern North Carolina. With a college and university, there's a vibrant and youthful spirit to the city & community. Greenville also has a distinct professional feel with the medical center and a strong pharmaceutical presence. The city itself has its commercial shopping areas, including Greenville Mall and 11 Galleria, movie theaters, restaurants, and strip malls, but its greatest charm is found in "Uptown" Greenville. The historic buildings of downtown Greenville house local restaurants, breweries, and shops -- just blocks from the Tar River and East Carolina University campus! Over the past several years more than \$650 million has been invested in Uptown and the Dickinson Art District ensuring the area will continue to see growth and development for years to come!

### **Church History**

Covenant Church was chartered in April of 1993. Through its first four years, Covenant experienced exponential growth leading to the expansion of its facilities, completed in 1999. In 2005, Branson Sheets was appointed the Lead Pastor of Covenant Church, its fourth pastor in its history. As Covenant continued to grow in both size and ministry, land was acquired across the street from its original facilities, and a new worship center was constructed, offering a 900-seat auditorium. In 2015, Covenant Church became a multi-site church with the launch of its Washington campus (20 miles east of Greenville). Beginning in 2021, Covenant Church has plans to continue planting campuses and gatherings throughout eastern North Carolina and beyond!

The vision of Covenant Church is about intentionally following Jesus. We believe it's all about Jesus. Regardless of our past failures and successes, our current circumstances, or our future plans, we're all human, and all in search of love, acceptance, and significance that comes only from Jesus. A dedication to passionate devotion and intentional obedience. Jesus said that the Father is seeking those who worship Him in Spirit and in Truth. A commitment to respect and integrity. Jesus' relationships were honest and genuine. We too are compelled to relate honestly with those inside and outside the church. In so doing, we are refreshed and encouraged by our love for one another. A command to look beyond ourselves. Jesus looked at broken humanity through the eyes of love and compassion and came to give His life away. We are called to see the world from God's perspective and give ourselves away as messengers of salvation, hope and healing. (Luke 10:25-37; Matthew 14:13-21; Luke 15:11-32; John 15:9-17; Colossians 3:12-14; 2 Samuel 9:1-13; Ruth 2:1-16)

A process for equipping and sending Christ's followers. Jesus intentionally modeled, trained and empowered people to be disciple-makers. ### **Overview of Weekly Worship Gathering**

Covenant Church hosts three weekend modern worship experiences at its Greenville Campus, including a Saturday evening (5:30 PM) and two on Sunday (9:15 & 11 AM) with live, simultaneous online worship experiences throughout the weekend! Covenant Church in Washington hosts an 11 AM modern worship experience with live teaching at the central campus. Each weekend includes modern, dynamic, mainstream worship music, and an engaging, lifeapplication message. Despite the size and robust worship experiences, people discover a sense of belonging at Covenant Church because of the warmth of people and dedication to hospitality.

### **Tell Us About Your Facility**

Covenant Church has a sprawling 30-acre campus with two large buildings and four former houses that are used for small groups and ministry purposes. Building A, our primary worship center, was completed in 2009 and seats 900 in its auditorium. It also has a two-story space used for Covenant Kids during its weekend worship experiences. Building B, the original building, is home to our Student Center, a 7,500 sq. ft. space that has an indoor recreation space, a full stage for worship and teaching, and a cafe and game room. Building B is also the location of the Covenant Preschool & Kindergarten. The upstairs of Building B is the church's main office, staff suites, and workspace, recently renovated at the end of 2021.

### **Denominational Affiliation and/or other Partnerships**

Currently, Covenant Church is part of The United Methodist Church of the North Carolina Conference. With the growing divide over theological and scriptural issues, the relationship between Covenant Church -- the largest in its conference -- and the denomination has reached an impasse that will soon result in a split. Covenant Church is currently aligned with the Wesleyan Covenant Association, a growing international association of evangelical churches but may consider becoming an independent, non-denominational church as well.

### **Governance & Polity**

Ultimately, Covenant Church is governed by its Church Council. This Council is made up of various leadership teams who lead its facilities, personnel, finances, and nominate its non-staff leadership. The Lead Pastor, in conjunction with an executive staff team, provides visionary leadership to both the staff and the church as a whole.

### **Current Paid Staffing Level**

Currently there are 27 full-time staff positions among the different ministry teams and an additional 25 part-time staff positions.

### **Major Ministries of the Church**

Covenant Church has a myriad of ministries or teams, including: Covenant Life (congregational ministries), Campus Development, Communication, Creative, Kids, Students, Worship Arts, Connections, and Outreach.

### **Outreach Programs Overview**

At Covenant Church, we've divided outreach into International and local. Since June 2021, our local outreach team has partnered with Beast Philanthropy to provide bi-weekly food distribution to local families. During this time, we have seen 229 volunteers help distribute food to over 3,000 households. Also, in February 2022, we partnered with the Tim Tebow Foundation to host a Night to Shine. The Night to Shine event is a prom night experience, centered on God's love for people with special needs ages 14 and older. A team of 180 volunteers welcomed over 100 special guests to our campus for this event. Internationally, the church has six global partners and sends teams at various points throughout the year.

### What theological hills will you die on?

Two things: 1.) The supremacy of Christ and 2.) the authority of scripture are the two theological "hills" that cannot be compromised. Anything that relegates Jesus to just a teacher, prophet, healer, or historical figure undermines his divine nature, which compromises the purpose of his sacrifice and resurrection. In addition, Covenant Church upholds the authority of the Bible as the source of transformative power, truth, and guidance -- not a religious book or historical account.

### **Hot-Button Social/Cultural Issues for Your Church**

One of the divisive issues that puts Covenant Church at odds with its denomination is over the issue of sexuality, particularly LGBTQ+. Covenant Church holds firm to a traditional view of a monogamous marriage between a man and a woman. Covenant Church also believes that scripture speaks clearly and authoritatively on the issue of sexuality and anything in contradiction to scripture is immoral and separates us from God.

### Biggest Church 'wins' in the last 18 months?

Over the past 18 months, Covenant has celebrated the baptisms of more than 35 adults and kids, welcomed new members and met hundreds of guests at worship services and events. In the summer of 2021, Covenant KIDS engaged with 600 children at its annual VBS and Student Ministry hosted its first conference - REAL - welcoming more than 220 students from the church and community! The growth behind these great programs and initiatives is a vibrant and youthful staff. For the first time in 20 years, the entire staff has started working together, collaboratively, in a newly renovated staff suite that has promoted unity, accountability, and productivity. This new development has set Covenant up for big wins, both now and for years to come!

As the leading evangelical church in our conference, Covenant Church is leading the way for churches exiting The United Methodist Church, presenting vast opportunities for partnerships, networks, and future campuses! The Director of Student Ministry is dedicated to reaching out to students in the community, empowering student leaders, and equipping/developing volunteers.

### **Goals and Expectations**

The greatest goal and expectation is to develop meaningful relationships with the students. Building relationships and trust with the students is paramount to any other goal or objective. In addition though, we'd love to see quarterly, dynamic, large-scale, community-wide events that draw middle & high school students from our community. As opportunities present themselves, we'd love for the Director of Student Ministry to have an increased presence in the local schools, connecting with current and prospective students. In addition, the development of three strategic, network-driven relationships with other student pastors/directors and leaders in the community.

### Do you have a job description for this role?

- >> Develops a student ministry with curriculum and events that will be executable across all campuses of Covenant Church
- >> Creates a compelling culture and environment that students are excited about and into which they are excited to invite their friends
- >> Helps students and adult leaders discover their gifts and helps connect them to appropriate ministry and serving opportunities in the church and where they live, work, and play
- >> Works with kids ministry and college ministry on programming and transitions that will make a consistent discipleship plan for students as they move on to next steps



- >> Primary communicator for high school and middle school ministry at the Winterville campus while developing the communication skills of other student ministry staff on other campuses

Ability to leverage social media for communication and connection to students.

### Attractional vs. Missional

Attractional - a majority of our ministry happens on/around weekend worship experiences. We recognize our need to shift the focus to become more missional in order to reach the unchurched in our community & expand into new communities throughout eastern North Carolina.

Including staffing, the general budget for Student Ministry is around \$150,000.

### **Personal Characteristics Desired**

Confident, personable, outgoing, heart for evangelism, passionate

### What would immediately disqualify someone?

Someone focused more on social justice, LGBTQ+, or issues than Jesus; someone who is apt to respond to complex issues like suicide by saying, "Everything happens for a reason"; anyone cohabitating with a future spouse (or non-spouse).

### **Urgency**

To begin during Summer 2022 or before fall semester. Sooner is certainly welcome.

Keen self-awareness, strong leadership, ability to collaborate with others
