Community Overview

Turlock and the surrounding areas are filled with a diverse population. Largely a farming and small business community, we are situated closely to the Bay Area, attracting people of all backgrounds. California State University, Stanislaus is located across town from the Crossroads Campus and attracts students from throughout the state.

The Crossroads campus is located near an Elementary School and High School in a quiet area of town away from the large shopping centers. This allows us to utilize our large campus in a variety of ways, to bring the community to us.

Why People Like Living Here

Locals love the small town vibes of Turlock, while still being in close proximity (2-hour drive) to large cities for shopping, the beach, and mountains. Additionally, Turlock has a diverse shopping market with both large box stores and small businesses, giving locals the amenities of both a large and small city. Due to the demographics of the area, a variety of cuisine is available at restaurants throughout town, including but not limited to; Chinese, Mexican, Indian, Sushi, Pho, Italian, Mediterranean and American. Our sprawling downtown area is known to host a large Farmers Market each weekend from May-October that attracts vendors far and wide. The Stanislaus County Fairgrounds (Located in Turlock) brings summer fun and entertainment to Turlock for the 2 weeks it operates. During the Christmas Season, Turlock runs a tree lighting ceremony downtown as well as the largely attended Christmas Parade.

Church History

Crossroads Church is a member of the Evangelical Free Church of America. Crossroads Church has a long history in the community of Turlock. Founded in 1906 by a group of twelve friends, Crossroads began as a missional outpost to reach the many workers of Swedish descent coming into the community to take advantage of the growing agricultural opportunities. By the 1930s the church became English-speaking and in 1951, it became part of the new Evangelical Free Church of America (https://www.crossroadsturlock.com). At its peak, more than 800 people called Crossroads their church home.

Today, Crossroads is a unique church in its neighborhood. The facility is a wonderful resource, comprising 56,000 square feet, and attenders would love to see it filled with people experiencing life transformation in Jesus. It sits on nine beautiful acres in a tranquil section of the city. The beautifully maintained campus contains dozens of trees and area residents visit the property daily to take advantage of the green space or the large, inviting playground that welcomes



younger children. This congregation wants to serve its neighbors and has commissioned a project to reimagine the back three acres of the property as a place for the community. With the installation of a new senior pastor in 2022, the church is trending in a great direction and truly has its best days ahead.

We are currently meeting together in one 10 AM worship service. Fall '23 the plans are to add an additional Sunday service making our worship times 8:45 & 10:30. The worship style could be categorized as contemporary but needs to continue to grow in this area. The preaching style would be considered expositional since the primary means of preaching is walking through books of the Bible verse by verse. We do take breaks from book series throughout the year to make sure we are covering other topics and issues that need to be addressed. The goal is a well-balanced diet of preaching and teaching.

Published Theological Statement

God

We believe in one God, Creator of all things, holy, infinitely perfect, and eternally existing in a loving unity of three



equally divine Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Having limitless knowledge and sovereign power, God has graciously purposed from eternity to redeem a people for Himself and to make all things new for His own glory.

The Bible

We believe that God has spoken in the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, through the words of human authors. As the verbally inspired Word of God, the Bible is without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for salvation, and the ultimate authority by which every realm of human knowledge and endeavor should be judged. Therefore, it is to be believed in all that it teaches, obeyed in all that it requires, and trusted in all that it promises.

The Human Condition

We believe that God created Adam and Eve in His image, but they sinned when tempted by Satan. In union with Adam, human beings are sinners by nature and by choice, alienated from God, and under His wrath. Only through God's saving work in Jesus Christ can we be rescued, reconciled and renewed.

Jesus Christ

We believe that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, one Person in two natures. Jesus—Israel's promised Messiah—was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father as our High Priest and Advocate.

The Work Of Christ

We believe that Jesus Christ, as our representative and substitute, shed His blood on the cross as the perfect, allsufficient sacrifice for our sins. His atoning death and victorious resurrection constitute the only ground for salvation.

The Holy Spirit

We believe that the Holy Spirit, in all that He does, glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ. He convicts the world of its guilt. He regenerates sinners, and in Him they are baptized into union with Christ and adopted as heirs in the family of God. He also indwells, illuminates, guides, equips and empowers believers for Christ-like living and service.

The Church

We believe that the true church comprises all who have been justified by God's grace through faith alone in Christ alone. They are united by the Holy Spirit in the body of Christ, of which He is the Head. The true church is manifest in local churches, whose membership should be composed only of believers. The Lord Jesus mandated two ordinances, baptism and the Lord's Supper, which visibly and tangibly express the gospel. Though they are not the means of salvation, when celebrated by the church in genuine faith, these ordinances confirm and nourish the believer.



Christian Living

We believe that God's justifying grace must not be separated from His sanctifying power and purpose. God commands us to love Him supremely and others sacrificially, and to live out our faith with care for one another, compassion toward the poor and justice for the oppressed. With God's Word, the Spirit's power, and fervent prayer in Christ's name, we are to combat the spiritual forces of evil. In obedience to Christ's commission, we are to make disciples among all people, always bearing witness to the gospel in word and deed.

Christ's Return

We believe in the personal, bodily and glorious return of our Lord Jesus Christ. The coming of Christ, at a time known only to God, demands constant expectancy and, as our blessed hope, motivates the believer to godly living, sacrificial service and energetic mission

Response And Eternal Destiny

We believe that God commands everyone everywhere to believe the gospel by turning to Him in repentance and receiving the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that God will raise the dead bodily and judge the world, assigning the unbeliever to condemnation and eternal conscious punishment and the believer to eternal blessedness and joy with the Lord in the new heaven and the new earth, to the praise of His glorious grace. Amen.
