Community Overview

The population of Sacramento is diverse and the church is located in a suburban area of the city, in a community of single-family homes developed in the early 1960's. The Sacramento State campus is across the street.

Why People Like Living Here

Fremont Presbyterian Church is located in desirable Sacramento, California, one block away from Sacramento State University and near both the mountains and the ocean. The Sierra Nevada Mountains are close by, with spectacular scenery, great hiking, and the stunning Lake Tahoe within a two-hour drive. The California coast and numerous beaches are also within a two-hour drive. The city provides a balance of bigger city life with a smaller city feel, and the cost of living is favorable compared to Los Angeles or the San Francisco Bay Area. Two large rivers converge in the city and Sacramento is known as the "City of Trees" due the to large number of tall mature trees in the city.

Church History

The church was formed in 1868 by a few families wishing to provide a Vacation Bible School to children living near the hop fields east of Sacramento. Due to an increase in the families being served, the church was incorporated in 1882 as 14th Street Presbyterian Church. It has been located in four locations throughout the city, with the current location chosen in 1960 due to expansive growth in what was a new housing development adjacent to the new university. The congregation voted to leave the PCUSA in 2012 and joined the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC).

Vision, Mission, Values

Fremont seeks to maximize the opportunity God has given us to create space for people to become lifelong followers of Jesus and to relentlessly pursue His transformation of our neighborhood, our city, and the world. We value a focus on Jesus Christ, quality and giving God our first fruits, relevance and having a positive impact in our community, every member ministry, growth as God leads, and being part of a denomination of like-minded and like-hearted Christ-following churches. The church has a membership of nearly 1,000 and is committed to a full and diverse set of ministries, including strong music, youth, and children's programs that connect with large numbers of community members. Fremont also has numerous active partnerships with local and global mission agencies.

Overview of Weekly Worship Gathering

Both traditional and contemporary worship services are offered on Sunday mornings. The Classic service is held in the 900-seat Sanctuary with a large pipe organ, choir, hymns, and traditional pews. The Modern Service is held in the Community Life Center with creative lighting, contemporary worship music led by a worship band, and multiple video screens.

Tell Us About Your Facility

Sacramento, CA

The Sanctuary, classrooms, and fellowship hall were built in the early 1960's, but the Sanctuary was remodeled in 2010 when a new 66-rank pipe organ was installed. A Chapel, which seats about 80 people, was constructed in 1985. The Community Life Center, including youth meeting space, classrooms, a large kitchen and a full-size gym was completed in 2004. The Main Office building was expanded in 2008.

Evangelical Presbyterian Church

Essentials of Our Faith

All Scripture is self-attesting and being Truth, requires our unreserved submission in all areas of life. The infallible Word of God, the sixty-six book of the Old Testament and New Testaments, is a complete and unified witness to God's redemptive acts culminating in the incarnation of the Living Word, the Lord Jesus Christ. The Bible, uniquely and fully inspired by the Holy Spirit, is the supreme and final authority on all matters on which it speaks. On this sure foundation we affirm these additional essentials of our faith:

- We believe in one God, the sovereign Creator and Sustainer of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. To Him be all honor, glory and praise forever!
- Jesus Christ, the living word, became flesh through His miraculous conception by the Holy Spirit and His virgin birth. He who is true God became true man united in one Person forever. He died on the cross a sacrifice for our sins according to the Scriptures. On the third day He arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven where, at the right hand of the Majesty on High, He now is our High Priest and Mediator.
- The Holy Spirit has come to glorify Christ and to apply the saving work of Christ to our hearts. He convicts us of sin and draws us to the Savior, indwelling in our hearts. He gives new life to us, empowers and imparts gifts to us for service. He instructs and guides us into all truth, and seals us for the day of redemption.
- Being estranged from God and condemned by our sinfulness, our salvation is wholly dependent upon the work of God's free grace. God credits His righteousness to those who put their faith in Christ alone for their salvation,



and thereby justifies them in His sight. Only such as are born of the Holy Spirit and receive Jesus Christ become children of God and heirs of eternal life.

- The true Church is composed of all persons who through saving faith in Jesus Christ and the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit are united together in the body of Christ. The Church finds her visible yet imperfect, expression in local congregations where the Word of God is preached in its purity and the sacraments are administered in their integrity, where scriptural discipline is practiced, and where loving fellowship is maintained. For her perfecting she awaits the return of her Lord.
- Jesus Christ will come again to the earth personally, visibly, and bodily to judge the living and the dead, and to consummate history and the eternal plan of God. "Even so, come, Lord Jesus." (Rev. 22:20)
- The Lord Jesus Christ commands all believers to proclaim the gospel throughout the world and to make disciples of all nations. Obedience to the Great Commission requires total commitment to "Him who loved us and gave Himself for us." He calls us to a life of self-denying love and service. "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."

These responsibilities include unifying and aligning communications, partnering with ministries, meeting with ministry leaders and creating communications plans to mobilize their specific audiences, ensuring that high-quality and highest impact communications are created for both internal and external audiences, and establishing a strategy and communication plan that is essential for the growth, health, and development of the church.



SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Collaboration

- Collaborate with church staff and ministry leaders to develop communications processes and define priorities to
 create an environment in which messages can be communicated clearly, creatively, and effectively to church-wide
 and specific audiences, as well as external audiences.
- Collaborate with church staff and ministry leaders to support their communications needs and to organize and plan communications messages in a timely manner.
- Collaborate with church staff and ministry leaders to develop strategy and messaging to enable Fremont to become more visible in the community and reach those not currently associated with the church.
- Educate staff members on communication/marketing issues and processes related to the church.

Leadership and Equipping

- Cultivate, lead and manage a team of coordinators, assistants and volunteers to help implement communications strategies and tactics. The team responsibilities include:
- Keeping social media and the website fresh and engaging.
- Networking with other church communication teams.
- Collecting and telling stories of life change.
- Photographing the ministry activities on Sundays, mission trips, VBS, etc.
- - Strategizing and planning communications/marketing for 6-12 months in advance.
- Graphic design and publication.
- Assisting with printing and production needs.
- - Writing text for church communications and publication.

Program Management and Implementation

- Carry out the day-to-day tasks of facilitating communications/marketing.
- Develop and implement all major communications efforts.
- Develop and manage the church's brand/identity.
- Create churchwide branding and style guidelines.
- Oversee graphic design and publication standards.
- Assess the types of communication that best meet the needs of the varying demographics of the congregation.
- Standardize messaging across all platforms: online, print, and in person.
- Oversee the maintenance and update of the website on a regular basis.
- Write and edit text for church communications and campaigns for use in various mediums and audiences.
- Collect stories of life-change within the church and develop ways to creatively communicate those stories via video, interviews, magazine, and other publications.



- Create campaigns to publicize Fremont's activities in the community and to attract people to on-campus services
 and events.
- Establish communication plans for sensitive issues like crisis communications, staff changes, or deaths.
- Develop and facilitate ways that the church can see and celebrate the work God is doing.
- Develop and manage the annual budget for communications.
