COMMUNITY OVERVIEW

CHURCH HISTORY

Mosaic Church launched in August of 2008. In the following years, Mosaic Church had to rent larger and larger facilities in order to accommodate the growth until 2015 when Mosaic purchased and renovated the Bienville Shopping Center. This new campus contains a 1,100 plus seat auditorium, 4,000 square foot lobby and public area, 9,000 square feet of children's area, 12,000 square feet of adult education and church administration offices, and over 375 parking spaces.

Over the past 4 years, the current pastor has been building a 20-year team. During that time the church has more than doubled in weekly attendance. Mosaic Church has a fantastic reputation in the region for being a church that is "for" people and works hard at reaching people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

These 4 values keep the vision of Mosaic Church clear:

- Truth: While there is truth in other sources, science, universities, and even other religions, the Bible is our standard for truth. Where other sources differ from the Bible, we rely on the Bible for absolute truth. We believe the Bible to be the inerrant Word of God.
- Worship: The Bible tells us the truth about who God is, and it also shows us the truth about who we are. If you know the truth about who God is, what He has done for you, and you know the truth of who we are, the only response is to worship Him. Truth leads to worship.
- Community: When you love something, don't you want to experience that "something" with other people who also love the same thing? Be it your favorite sports team, hobby, etc.; you likely enjoy it with people who also love it. This is community. Christianity is no different in this respect. Because we love Jesus, we naturally want to do this thing called Christianity with others who love Jesus.
- Outreach: Lastly, the more we love something, the more we want others who are NOT involved to experience what we love. This naturally leads to outreach, our fourth core value. There are over 180,000 people on the MS Gulf Coast that do not know Jesus. Our mission is to introduce them to the "real" Jesus and connect them to one another.

MAJOR MINISTRIES OF THE CHURCH

MoKids!:

• MoKids! ministers to children birth-5th Grade. MoKids! meet during all worship services.

Student Ministry:

Student Ministry ministers to teens 6th-12th grade. Middle Schoolers meet at the church on Sunday evenings from 5-6:30pm. High Schoolers meet in homes throughout the community on Sunday evenings from 5-6:30pm.

• Our Lay Counseling ministry is designed help people overcome obstacles in their life and reach their full potential in Jesus Christ by providing practical, applicable, and life-changing truths/resources from God's Word and life experiences.

Mentoring Programs:

• We believe that the greatest threat to a person's faith may never be addressed in a weekend service, but could be immediately addressed in the right relationship. Our mentoring program is designed to provide this relationship.

The Bible

The Bible is God's Word to us and was written by human authors under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. We believe that all of scripture points towards the Gospel. The gospel is the good news of God's grace invading the darkness of this world. It is the grand narrative of creation, the fall, redemption, and consummation ordained by God and orchestrated through the life, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus Christ. Christ's crucifixion is the heart of the gospel. His resurrection is the power of the gospel. His ascension is the glory of the gospel.

It's All About Jesus

We believe that the Bible and all of human history points to one person, Jesus and that Jesus is 100% man and 100% God. Because of this, everything we do is all about Jesus. Our goal for ministry is: make Jesus clear and love people.

The Trinity

In the very beginning, there was God. God has always been and will always be and has eternally existed in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is three persons in one God, with all three persons being equal without one being superior over the other.

Jesus

We believe that the eternal Son of God and second person of the Trinity became flesh, adding humanity to his divinity, and entered into human history as the God-Man, Jesus Christ. Jesus alone is one person with two natures, fully God and fully man. The Holy Spirit miraculously conceived Jesus Christ and born of the Virgin Mary in Bethlehem to redeem sinful man as the only mediator between God and man. We believe that Jesus Christ lived a perfectly righteous and sinless life, died in place of sinners, fully absorbing the wrath of God, paying the just penalty for their sins and reconciling them to God. Because He is both our Savior and example, we genuinely love Jesus Christ and seek to live with and like Him by the power of the Holy Spirit.



The Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ. From the moment a person surrenders their life to Jesus Christ, The Holy Spirit inhabits every part of who they are. He provides conviction of sins, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. The Holy Spirit creates within every believer a Spiritual Gift in which they use to further God's Kingdom and reach non-believers for the sake of the Gospel. As Christians, we seek to live under the constant guidance of The Holy Spirit.

Human Beings

Humans stand separated from all creation as the only created being that is made in the image of God. Although every person has tremendous potential for good, all human beings are sinners by both nature and choice. All fallen people are by nature sinners, children of wrath, and destined to death. Therefore, all sinners need a savior and a new nature, that's why we trust in Jesus alone for new and eternal life.

Salvation

Through faith, we are united with the risen Christ, raised with Christ, and granted the same Holy Spirit power that raised Christ. The benefits of Jesus' resurrection include the forgiveness of sins, justification, sanctification, and ultimately glorification. We believe that justification through the work of Jesus Christ is possible by grace alone, through faith alone, in Jesus Christ alone. His righteousness is imparted to us at the time of saving faith, simultaneous with our justification, and brings us new life by the Holy Spirit, who regenerates us with a new nature and begins sanctifying us to become increasingly more like Jesus. Salvation is a gift that is only made possible through the works of Jesus Christ, and because of this, we believe that everything we do will rise and fall on the actions of Jesus.

Baptism

Baptism is for the individual who has received the saving benefits of Christ's atoning work and has become His disciple. In obedience to Christ's command and as a testimony of faith, a believer should be baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Water baptism symbolizes a person's union with Christ in the likeness of His death and resurrection. It signifies that a former way of life has been put to death and depicts a release from the mastery of sin. Mosaic Church practices and teaches believer's baptism. Before being baptized at Mosaic Church, we require you to walk through Baptism Class. The class covers the biblical significance of baptism, frequently asked questions and gives you an opportunity to share your testimony. If you were baptized as a believer before Mosaic Church, we don't require you to be baptized again unless your baptism preceded conversion.
