We have a great mix of younger and older families and a lot of solid volunteers. CHURCH HISTORY

Our people take a healthy ownership of our church. They serve above and beyond and always want to do something to help in any way they can. Our current Lead Pastor has been here for over 5 years. He is a former student and young adult pastor from California.

OVERVIEW OF WEEKLY WORSHIP GATHERING

We are not trendy, but neither are we stale. We value worship and creativity in our Sunday experience and don't make it about any one person. We make a conscious decision to focus on the Lord. We like to have fun. We don't take ourselves seriously. We say, "We are a church for messed up people, saved by God's grace. No matter where you've been – you are welcome here." We believe this. We take communion weekly. We have several songs with a service host and then a biblically-based message focused on reaching people, not professors.

WORSHIP STYLE OF YOUR CHURCH

Our worship is active and upbeat, but not trendy. We do sing Hillsong, Bethel music, and others. We desire for this to be an interactive part of our service. Many describe our worship element as a huge draw for our church community.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR FACILITY

Our original facility was built in 2007. In 2016, we completed some improvements, adding student space upstairs, an elevator, office space, etc. On March 31, 2017, about 4 months after completing this renovation, our church was leveled by a tornado. We built a completely new church and opened up in January 2019. It has been incredible to see people return and worship in the new building. We have a modern feel to our design and do all we can to keep things in good working order, fresh, and not outdated. We now have roughly 29,000 SF of building with 14 acres that we own around us for future expansion.

MAJOR MINISTRIES OF THE CHURCH

- Thriving Children's Ministry!
- Student Ministry needs to be split into middle/high school (hence the hire) but sees around 70 kids per weekend.
- Budding Young Adult Ministry is currently led by two awesome volunteers but could use some more staff backing.
- Incredible worship team and tech experience.
- Teaching is biblically based and challenging but always applicable.
- We run something called Welcome to Real Life once a month to connect new people to the staff/elders.

OUTREACH PROGRAMS OVERVIEW

We really push serving in and out of the church. But we don't just want people serving on big serving days. We offer grant money to each Community Group to see a need and serve together to address the issue. On top of that, we do



have two large serve days per year where we will pack 10,000 meals with Rise Against Hunger and work to serve in around 15 area projects in our area. We partner with schools, communities, neighborhoods, etc. Serving is a part of our DNA.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

ABOUT GOD

God created the entire universe –heaven and earth– even life itself. The complexity and wonder of the universe is evidence of God's existence and power. (Genesis 1) God eternally exists in three distinct persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (2 Corinthians 13:14)

ABOUT JESUS

Jesus is the one and only Son of God. He became flesh to reveal God to humanity. (John 1) Jesus died and then rose from the dead so that my sins could be forgiven and so that I could receive the gift of eternal life. (John 3:16) After his death, burial, and resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven. He will return at the appointed time to judge the living and the dead. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)

ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit is equal with the Father and the Son as God. He is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ. (John 16:7-13) He also lives in every believer from the moment of salvation. (Acts 2:38; Ephesians 1:13) He provides the Christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. (John 1:12, 14:6; Romans 5:1, 6:23; Galatians 3:26; Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:5)

ABOUT BAPTISM

Baptism is a necessary step in your spiritual journey of faith in Christ. At Real Life we believe every person who places their faith in Christ should be baptized as a response to Christ's commandment. Every example of New Testament Baptism we see in the Bible demonstrates that first a person comes to believe in Christ, repents of their sinful life, and then he or she is baptized (some examples: Acts 2:38, 8:38-39, and 10:43-48) Baptism is the means by which followers of Christ are identified. (Matthew 28:19)

ABOUT THE CHURCH

The church is the "body of Christ" here on earth. As part of His body, we are empowered by the Holy Spirit to share the good news of God with others and to love them into the Kingdom of God. The Church was instituted by God, commissioned by Christ, and led by the power of the Holy Spirit. The Church of Jesus Christ is the hope of the world. (Ephesians 4:1-16)

ABOUT LEADERSHIP IN THE CHURCH

Jesus is the head of the church and has all authority. We seek to reflect His priorities in all that we do and to make decisions that are consistent with Jesus' teachings. (Matthew 28:18; Ephesians 1:22-23; 1 Peter 4:4) Real Life Christian Church is "staff led" and "elder empowered." The Lead Pastor works with the elders to establish vision and direction and works with the staff to make sure that the vision and direction are implemented.



MARRIAGE

Section 1

Statement on Marriage and Sexuality.

- We believe the term "marriage" has only one meaning and that is marriage sanctioned by God which joins one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture.
- We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to only occur between a man and a woman who are married to each other.
- We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman.
- We believe that any form of sexual immorality, such as adultery, fornication, homosexuality, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, pornography or any attempt to change one's sex, or disagreement with one's biological gender, is sinful and offensive to God.
- We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of the church as the local Body of Christ, and to provide a biblical role model to the church members and the community, it is imperative that all persons employed by the church in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, should abide by and agree to this Statement on Marriage and Sexuality and conduct themselves accordingly.
- We believe that God offers redemption and restoration to all who confess and forsake their sin, seeking His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus Christ.
- We believe that God extends His saving grace to humankind. Following God's example, we believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect and dignity. Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward individuals or people groups is to be repudiated and is not in accord with scripture nor the doctrines of the church.

Section 2

• Real Life Christian Church maintains that a significant part of God's plan to reveal himself in Creation is clearly indicated in God's Word, the Bible, to be a "one flesh" marriage covenant between one man and one woman who are faithfully committed to one another for life. Established in Genesis (Genesis 1:26-28), this plan is reiterated by Jesus Christ (Matthew 19:4-5, Mark 10:6-9) and reaffirmed by the Apostle Paul (Ephesians 5:31). We further maintain it is the responsibility of the Church to interpret the Bible in establishing all covenantal relationships.

Section 3

• The only weddings that will be held on Real Life Christian Church premises or conducted by Real Life Christian Church pastors, staff or elders will be those between one man and one woman (born as male and female) who are wholly committed to one another as lifelong companions.

The role of High School/Young Adults Pastor at Real Life Christian Church is to build leadership teams that create environments and foster relationships to equip them) oversee to live Jesus > everything now and throughout their life.

- This person must be highly relational, energetic, dynamic, and have a self-driven passion for reaching, training, and equipping those they oversee to reach, train and equip others to follow Jesus.
- Must be passionate about Jesus in his own life and believe that High School and Young Adults is the most important ministry in the church.
- Needs to demonstrate the ability to create, plan, execute and evaluate successful events, leadership development, and program growth.

Personal Responsibilities:

This individual must demonstrate a shepherd's heart for people and model biblical priorities by being committed to:

- Spending regular time in God's Word and prayer.
- Faithfully supporting the ministry of RLCC by giving regularly.
- Must demonstrate spiritual maturity and a growing relationship with Jesus.
- Displays a balance of humility and drive to build God's kingdom.



Responsibilities:

As a church, we use the following values in our strategy:

- (Community) Growing people deeper in relationships with Jesus and others.
- (Service) Leading our people to seek opportunities to serve both inside and outside the church walls.
- (Family) Equipping marriages and parents to thrive practically and spiritually.
- The High School/ Young Adult ministry pastor's primary focus is on the family, but community and service play a part in how they should structure their ministry.

- Select, prepare and teach the High School curriculum.
- Assume responsibility for quality control of overall HS/YA environments.
- Develop and deliver High School services that help deepen students' faith.
- Oversee YA gathering and leadership.
- Create events and environments that are designed for welcoming and loving friends, and being intentional in helping guests get connected to others and Jesus.
- Implement ways to partner with parents to develop students' faith.
- Oversee small group ministry and ensure it aligns with other programming and overall church vision.
- Maintain a safe environment, including requiring background checks of all volunteers, avoiding dangerous activities, and ensuring that liability release forms for students are completed.
- Meet and mentor interns, leaders, and parents.
- Build student and young adult leaders (creating disciples).
- Pastor and provide resources to kids/families in crisis.
- Communicate, promote, and prepare for meetings/events/trips (local and overseas).
- Plan the budget and monitor spending.

REQUIREMENTS/QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have experience in student ministry in a program of at least 75 students.
- Must exhibit strong leadership skills with high school students, parents, young adults, as well as adult volunteers. Must be able to communicate relationally with large and small groups.
- Must provide relevant, interesting, creative, and appropriate programming skills—large groups, small groups, worship team.



- Must place a high value on quality discipleship with those they oversee.
- Must be a team player; able to work well with the people within this ministry, as well as the other ministries and staff.
