CHURCH HISTORY

Redeemer City Church (member of EFCA) is a growing member of the Acts 29 network of churches. Originally planted in 2014 from a sister church in our network, the church has grown from a small church plant of 17 core members meeting in a local elementary school to a self-sustaining congregation of over 60 members and around 100 weekly attenders that meet in our own building (opened in 2019). Led by core values of "Gospel, Community and Mission," Redeemer City seeks to declare and demonstrate the Gospel in the city.

VISION, MISSION, VALUES

Redeemer City's mission is to seek to renew our city through the gospel.

Our vision is to see a gospel movement that reconciles people back to God and transforms them into a community that is sent out to love and serve the city. We hope to see our city experience spiritual, social, and cultural renewal through the demonstration and declaration of the gospel for the glory of God.

Our core values can be summed up in three words: gospel, community, and mission. These are the fundamental convictions that drive, shape, and undergird the mission and vision of Redeemer City.

Gospel

• The gospel literally means "news that brings joy." The good news found in the Scriptures is that, through Christ, the power of God's kingdom has entered history to renew the whole world. This renewing work of Jesus rescues us from our sin and changes us from the inside out into people who desire to live like Him.

Community

• The gospel not only reconciles us back to God, it also reconciles us to one another into a new family. It is in the context of this new family that we learn and grow to love one another regardless of our differences, with the same love Christ has shown us.

Mission

• The gospel not only welcomes us in but also sends us out. In John 20:21, Jesus says, "As the Father has sent me, so now I send you." This means that we are called to participate with God in his mission. We seek to embody and proclaim the gospel winsomely both in the city of Madison as well as abroad through strategic partnerships in Guatemala and North Africa.

OVERVIEW OF WEEKLY WORSHIP GATHERING

Each week, we seek to center around the good news of the Gospel. Our worship style can be best described as a blend of contemporary and traditional approaches, such as that used by Norton Hall Band or Worship Initiative. Our philosophy of worship is guided by a desire to select music that engages heart and mind, centering our congregation's thoughts on the good news of God's Word and the Gospel. During worship, we incorporate a time of confession and assurance, as well as celebrating the Lord's supper. The preaching is expositional with a gospel-centered application. We believe that what both the non-believer and the Christian need is the gospel. For the non-christian, so they can know how they can receive God's grace in Christ, and for the Christian so that he or she can live out of the Grace in Christ (Col 2:6-7).

PUBLISHED THEOLOGICAL STATEMENT

Article 1. God

• We believe in one God, Creator of all things, holy, infinitely perfect, and eternally existing in a loving unity of three equally divine Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Having limitless knowledge and sovereign power, God has graciously purposed from eternity to redeem a people for Himself and to make all things new for His own glory.

Article 2.The Bible

• We believe that God has spoken in the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, through the words of human authors. As the verbally inspired Word of God, the Bible is without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for salvation, and the ultimate authority by which every realm of human knowledge and endeavor should be judged. Therefore, it is to be believed in all that it teaches, obeyed in all that it requires, and trusted in all that it promises.

Article 3.The Human Condition

• We believe that God created Adam and Eve in His image, but they sinned when tempted by Satan. In union with Adam, human beings are sinners by nature and by choice, alienated from God, and under His wrath. Only through God's saving work in Jesus Christ can we be rescued, reconciled and renewed.

Article 4.Jesus Christ

• We believe that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, one Person in two natures. Jesus—Israel's promised Messiah—was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father as our High Priest and Advocate.

Article 5.The Work of Christ

 We believe that Jesus Christ, as our representative and substitute, shed His blood on the cross as the perfect, allsufficient sacrifice for our sins. His atoning death and victorious resurrection constitute the only ground for salvation.

Article 6.The Holy Spirit

• We believe that the Holy Spirit, in all that He does, glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ. He convicts the world of its guilt. He regenerates sinners, and in Him they are baptized into union with Christ and adopted as heirs in the family of God. He also indwells, illuminates, guides, equips and empowers believers for Christ-like living and service.

Article 7.The Church

• We believe that the true church comprises all who have been justified by God's grace through faith alone in Christ alone. They are united by the Holy Spirit in the body of Christ, of which He is the Head. The true church is manifest in local churches, whose membership should be composed only of believers. The Lord Jesus mandated two ordinances, baptism and the Lord's Supper, which visibly and tangibly express the gospel. Though they are not the means of salvation, when celebrated by the church in genuine faith, these ordinances confirm and nourish the believer.

Article 8. Christian Living

• We believe that God's justifying grace must not be separated from His sanctifying power and purpose. God commands us to love Him supremely and others sacrificially, and to live out our faith with care for one another, compassion toward the poor and justice for the oppressed. With God's Word, the Spirit's power, and fervent prayer in Christ's name, we are to combat the spiritual forces of evil. In obedience to Christ's commission, we are to make disciples among all people, always bearing witness to the gospel in word and deed.

Article 9.Christ's Return

• We believe in the personal, bodily and glorious return of our Lord Jesus Christ. The coming of Christ, at a time known only to God, demands constant expectancy and, as our blessed hope, motivates the believer to godly living, sacrificial service and energetic mission.

Article 10. Response and Eternal Destiny

• We believe that God commands everyone everywhere to believe the gospel by turning to Him in repentance and receiving the Lord Jesus Christ. We believe that God will raise the dead bodily and judge the world, assigning the unbeliever to condemnation and eternal conscious punishment and the believer to eternal blessedness and joy with the Lord in the new heaven and the new earth, to the praise of His glorious grace. Amen.

The Scriptures teach that marriage is between one man and one woman. All other forms of sexual intimacy, including all forms of lust and same-sex activity of any kind are sinful. (Rom 1:18-32, 1 Cor 6:9).

That said, we also believe that everyone stands in need of God's grace for sexual sin, and that sexual immorality is a pardonable sin through repentance and faith.

BIGGEST CHURCH 'WINS' IN LAST 18 MONTHS?

The biggest church "wins" in the last 18 months is adding two new qualified Elders and two new Deacons to our leadership team. We have a growing culture of healthy leaders that are committed and moving the church forward toward its vision.

BIGGEST OPPORTUNITY FOR YOUR CHURCH IN THE NEXT 12 MONTHS

The biggest opportunity in the next 12 months is outreach to our neighborhood in partnership with the Hispanic church that meets at our facility. We are in the midst of some intentional outreach in which members of both churches

have been trained in evangelism and have gone out on a regular basis to do a survey which helps us to get to know the neighborhood better, while also opening doors to share the gospel. We are also planning a large neighborhood party so that we can get to know our neighbors and they can get to know us.

CHURCH'S BIGGEST CHALLENGE FOR THE FUTURE

The biggest challenge is entering a season in which the dominant demographic in our church is young families. This is stretching for us, as the availability of many of our leaders is shrinking due to the great gift of children! Being able to navigate this with wisdom and faithfulness to our mission will be challenging.
