Church History

- September 2000: Willowbrook Community Church held its first public church service at the Forest Lake High School Auditorium
- December 2010: Renovated and moved into a strip mall location in the heart of Forest Lake (rental property)
- January 2022: Raised \$250,000.00 and purchased 10 acres of farmland in Lino Lakes (few miles south of Forest Lake) as a potential new location to build a church home.
- July 2022: Renamed our church to: The Community Co (like co-op, not company)
- July 2022: Left the strip mall location (lease was up and landlord raised rent almost 3x so we were forced to move) and landed at the LILA Upper School for church services on Sunday mornings, renting their space for church Sunday.
- May 2023: Renewed our rental contract with LILA for another 3 years

We have 1 service at 10am on Sunday mornings. There is full kids programming available at the same time as adult service for kids birth-5th grade. We generally begin with a countdown to the hour, worship set 3-4 songs, announcements, sermon bumper video, sermon, dismiss.

We serve communion once each month, generally the 3rd or 4th Sunday.

Published Theological Statement

We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, inerrant in its original manuscripts. The Bible is our supreme and final authority in faith and life. (II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:20, 21)

Overall Description of this Position

The Lead Pastor is responsible to provide leadership and oversee the direction, thrust, and ministry of the entire church, including its priorities and spiritual vitality. This person shall be the spiritual leader of the church, and shall preach and teach the Word, lead the public church services, administer ordinances, and lead its members in a practical Christian life.

The Lead Pastor shall direct the church staff, provide counsel, encouragement and Christian discipline, so as to assist in the accomplishment of objectives for each staff member. All staff is ultimately responsible to the Lead pastor, either directly through his/her position or through the Executive Pastor.

The qualifications of the Lead Pastor should be as set forth in I Timothy 3:1-7. The Lead Pastor is to be accountable to the Board of Directors on the basis of competence and moral character.

The lead pastor reports to the Board of Directors.

Goals and Expectations
