

WEEK ONE

Thank God for answering prayer through the hiring process. Pray in specific ways for the new staff member transition as they pack, travel and prepare.

Philippians 1:3-6 - I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always offering prayer with joy in my every prayer for you all, in view of your participation in the gospel from the first day until now. For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work among you will complete it by the day of Christ Jesus.

WEEK THREE

Pray for spiritual refreshment before the Lord.

Pray for any transition challenges, delays, difficulties in travel or obstacles to not lessen the confidence in God's call to this new season of ministry.

Pray that "God's goodness and love" would be evident in their life.

Pray through the 23rd Psalm

WEEK TWO

Pray that the current staff remains steadfast through this transition and everyday life. Pray for the incoming staff's housing details, new friendships, wrapping up of their current situation and other transition details to go well.

1 Corinthians 15:58 - Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be firm, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

WEEK FOUR

Pray that God would protect the entire staff from spiritual attacks and that their walk with God, marriages, and families may be strengthened. Pray that God's faithfulness would be a source of encouragement. Pray for receptivity by the community and congregation to the new staff.

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 - Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will do it.
